
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






# STEM WORKSHOPS







FAYETTE COUNTY 4-H COUNCIL'S 2025 BREAKFAST WITH SANTA (SATURDAY, DECEMBER 13<sup>TH</sup>) WILL INCLUDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR YOUTH VENDORS FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT, 9AM-12PM. THIS OPPORTUNITY WILL ALLOW FOR YOUTH 9-18 (4-H AGE) TO EARN ABOUT PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT & PRICING, PACKAGING, MARKETING, MONEY HANDLING, AND CUSTOMER SERVICE, ALONG WITH BEING ABLE TO SELL THEIR GOODS TO CUSTOMERS AT BREAKFAST WITH SANTA.

BUSINESSES ARE ALLOWED TO HAVE UP TO 3 YOUTH AT THEIR TABLE, AND EACH CHILD MUST FILL OUT AN APPLICATION. EACH FAMILY IS ALLOWED TO APPLY FOR A MAXIMUM OF 1 VENDOR SLOT, BUT IF THIS FAMILY HAS MORE THAN 3 CHILDREN THEN ALL CHILDREN IN THE FAMILY MAY BE AT THE TABLE.
